The 19th annual San Pedro ♥ Festival of the Arts bursts onto the Peck Park lawn this September 20, bringing 18 vibrant dance companies, interactive performances, and free family fun to the heart of the harbor. Bring a picnic blanket, join in a Bollywood step or a flamenco turn, and enjoy an afternoon of world-class dance under the San Pedro sun!

A unique feature will be called "2 Moves" – a chance for the audience to learn "2 Moves" from each performance before or between dances, turning spectators into participants and getting a chance to experience some of the nuances of the piece. Those in the audience who wish, can learn and dance on the lawn and return to their chairs or blankets to watch the next dances. A free raffle drawing will also take place during the show!

Some History

Thirteen years ago, the TriArt Festival moved to Ports O' Call Village, drawing thousands of new spectators, performers, and vendors, and helping to establish San Pedro as a center for the arts. With site construction underway, the festival relocated over the years—across from the USS Iowa, one year at Crafted, several years at Anderson Park—and now proudly returns to Peck Park. This marks its third year at this location, with live performances once again, plus streaming available for two weeks after the event.

Original founder, Joe Caccavalla, envisioned the dance, music, and visual arts crafts as the heart of the festival to foster art appreciation. After his death in 2012, the producers reformed as SAN PEDRO ▼ TRI ART Festival, and since then, our audience attendance has grown with increased recognition. It has become best known for its dance performances, which is again the focus this year.

Los Angeles Choreographers & Dancers (LA C&D), directed by Louise Reichlin, has long been a key producer and fiscal receiver of the festival, securing grants from the Department of Cultural Affairs, City of Los Angeles, and curating by committee a diverse lineup each year. This year's program spans Modern, Ballet, Contemporary, East and South Indian, Jazz, Flamenco, Middle Eastern (Traditional into Contemporary), and Tap/Stomp, featuring both professional and pre-professional companies sharing their artistry with the community.
